CONSTITUTION

Organized 2013 Incorporated 2013

I. Name

The name of this organization shall be the Association for Special Needs Activities and Programs, Inc. (A-SNAP)

II. Purpose

- 1. This organization shall promote the general welfare of people with special needs and their families in the area.
- 2. To provide programs and services for people with special needs and their families in cooperation with local, state, and federal governmental agencies.
- 3. To solicit and receive funds to carry out its corporate purposes.

III. Executive Committee

The executive committee shall consist of the president, the vice president, the treasurer and the secretary. (Election, duties and responsibilities are stated in Bylaws)

IV. Board of Directors

The board of directors shall consist of the president, vice president, treasurer, secretary and five (5) members additional members voted at large and one (1) additional member that receives direct benefits from A-SNAP. This additional member will be appointed by the other members of the Board of Directors at the first meeting of each year. (Election, duties and responsibilities are stated in Bylaws)

V. Membership

- 1. Full membership is open to member of the public who has completed and submitted a membership form
- 2. Members shall:
 - a. Be eligible to serve as an officer on the Executive Committee or the Board of Directors
 - b. Elect officers and members of the Executive committee
 - c. Approve and vote the annual budget

VI. Amendment

This constitution and bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the membership present and voting at any meeting; provided a written copy of any proposed amendment, alteration or repeal is sent to each director at least 14 days before the meeting at which it is to be considered.

VII. Law

The Constitution and Bylaws of the A-SNAP shall be binding on the members. Any action inconsistent therewith shall be null and void.
